Challenge to Serve

For the past few months we have been walking side by side with Hebrews 11 and the book of Genesis. We have looked at what "faith" is, and how that faith puts into action the "understanding" of who God is, and what He has asked us, to do as His followers.

Faith, as the writer of Hebrews has defined it, and we have used it these past few months, is "the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." (Hebrews 11:1, KJV) So, faith is "evidence" and with the "evidence" we are called to move in action according to James 2:14 - 26. But, I think that is where we have gotten stuck. We have faith, but do we have works?

James states in verses 15 - 16, of the same chapter, that "If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that?" then we are not completing the puzzle. "Faith without works is dead" (James 2:17)

So, I would challenge us as individuals to get our family together and go beyond our Christian cliches and put our faith into action. For the month of June, I challenge us to do the following: Prayerfully, pick 2 individuals or families who you know are caring a burden. Then find 1 ways you can tangibly meet their needs (more than a phone call, text or card). I would encourage us to do this for the entire month.

When we look to Scripture, we see this is how the early church did things. Acts 4:32 – 35 gives us this model "Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common. And with great power the apostles were giving their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all. There was not a needy person among them, for as many as were owners of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of what was sold and laid it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to each as any had need."

The point is not to go and sell everything, but that needs are seen and meet. What kind of witness would the church have if we came back to this?
